Early Years Foundation Stage

The percentage of pupils achieving a 'good level of development' (at least 'expected' attainment in Reading, Writing and Maths) in 2017 was 73% compared with the national figure of 71% and Cheshire East was 72%.

Progress across Key Stage 2

Progress over Key Stage 2 (Years 3-6) is now measured by comparing children's Key Stage 1 teacher assessment figures with their Key Stage 2 SATs scores (or Teacher Assessments in Writing) with a score of '0' representing expected progress (based on similar pupils nationally) and anything above this showing more the expected progress. The table below shows the school's progress figures:
