Lacey Green Primary Academy Results* Summary 2018

Early Years Foundation Stage

The percentage of pupils achieving a 'good level of development' (at least 'expected' attainment in Reading, Writing and Maths) in 2018 was 72% the same as the national figure of 72%.

Key Stage 1

Key Stage 2

The table below shows the percentages of ALL pupils achieving the 'Expected Standard' and above (based on Key Stage 2 SATs for Reading, GPS (Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling), Maths and Teacher Assessment in Writing) compared with National and Cheshire East figures:

GPS	98%	78%	82%
Maths (M)	96%	76%	77%
Writing (W)	94%	78%	80%
Combined R/W/M	85%	64%	67%

Percentages of pupils achieving the 'Higher Standard' in each subject (a scaled score of 110 or more in Reading, GPS, Maths and Teacher Assessed in Writing) were as follows:

Reading	42%	28%	31%
SPaG	77%	34%	36%
Maths	48%	24%	25%
Writing	29%	20%	15%

As well as being judged in relation to the 'Expected Standard', all pupils received a 'Scaled Score' for Reading, SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar) and Maths (the Expected Standard being represented by the number 100). The table below shows the school's average figures compared with those of pupils nationally:

Progress across Key Stage 2

Progress over Key Stage 2 (Years 3-6) is now measured by comparing children's Key Stage 1 teacher assessment figures with their Key Stage 2 SATs scores (or Teacher Assessments in Writing) with a score of '0' representing expected progress (based on similar pupils nationally) and anything above this showing more than the expected progress. The table below shows the school's progress figures:
