Aspire to achieve...

Aims and Expectations:

Rationale:

We believe that the wearing of a school uniform enables children to identify with their school, gives a sense of belonging, is practical and smart, reinforces a positive work ethos and reduces expenditure for parents/carers.

Aims:

- All children wear the correct uniform to school
- Children feel proud to belong to the school
- Parents/carers share the expectations of the school

Guidelines:

- It is expected that children wear the school uniform each day, with the appropriate footwear.
- The school web site provides parents/carers with full details of the school uniform and an order form which shows prices of the uniform to be worn (see below).
- Most items of uniform can be purchased from the school office – see details below.
- Second-hand items are occasionally available via the PTA and the school office at prices to be agreed.
- If a child does not wear the correct uniform, a verbal or written reminder of our expectations will be communicated to the child and when necessary to the parents/carers
- If a child arrives at school wearing inappropriate clothing which causes concern (eg unsuitable for the weather, too revealing, offensive/unsuitable slogans, etc) then the school will provide uniform for the child to wear for the day.
- PE kit should be kept in school all week and only taken home at weekends for washing.
- If a child does not have their PE kit in school, a letter is sent home to the parents/carers.
- **Parents are asked to clearly label every item of school clothing with their child's name.**
- The children are responsible for taking care of their own items of uniform.
- There are baskets for lost property located in each key stage. Any items left unclaimed are periodically disposed of (at the end of each half term).
- If there is any reason why a child cannot wear our uniform or requires special dispensation (eg: health or religious grounds) then the governors will consider sympathetically any such request from a parent/carer.

**Jeans, high-heeled shoes/boots, fashion shoes, trainers, football shirts, shirts with large slogans/logos etc. are not acceptable school wear.*

PE Kit:

- Lacey Green Navy/Green PE Kit – Top and Shorts.

OR (if already a pupil in school during 2018/2019 year and you are unable to purchase the 'new' PE Kit))

- School logo white T-shirt or **Plain** White T-shirt
- Plain green school shorts,
- Trainers or plimsolls.
- A tracksuit (for cold weather outdoors - is also useful for outdoor activities during the winter).

NO football shirts, shirts with slogans or logos

Jewellery:

NB: On Health and Safety grounds, we do not allow children to wear jewellery to school. The exceptions to this are TWO stud pierced ear-rings. We will ask the children who are wearing stud ear-rings to remove these during PE lessons.

Plasters are no longer allowed to cover the earrings during PE.

ALL children must be capable of removing their own earrings (adults will not do this for them!) This is to prevent them from causing injury.

NB: We will not accept only one earring being worn.

Please have ears pierced during the 6 week holiday to allow healing time!

Hair and Hairstyles:

No 'extreme' hairstyles are allowed, including tram-lines, pattern, **aggressively shaven (Number one) boys hair, or use of hair colourants or dyes.**

It is essential to tie back long hair during the school day so that it does not distract children when working. Also loose hair causes greater problems with head lice.
