Dear Parents / Carers,

Just to let you know that our staff team are doing an amazing job with the increased demands, workload and pressures caused by the Coronavirus outbreak. We are exceptionally proud of our team.

Headline notes:

- **Home learning website is nearly completed.**

We have had some parents asking for work to be sent home for those choosing or needing to self-isolate. We are working on a list of websites to use should the school close. We have told all staff not to produce additional work as we do not want to add further pressures to them at this moment in time. Our primary focus is the health, safety and welfare of our children and trying our best to keep the school open. The website list will go live soon but in the meantime your children can:

- Read Daily
- Keep a written diary of events / learning / thoughts and pictures
- Complete at least 1 hour of physical activity each day.

Parents are advised to read the government's guidance on staying at home in the case of suspected coronavirus infection. This is based on the most significant symptoms of:

- **new continuous cough, and/or**
- **high temperature (37.8°C+)**

If children develop either of these symptoms, they should be kept at home for a period of 7 days from the onset of the symptoms. Full details are available here:
