Things that may hinder the cotton from being made into clothes!

- It might rain too much meaning that the cotton will drown and not grow
- The cotton might not grow due to no rain or sunlight
- When the cotton fabric is drying it might rain and be really windy meaning that it could fall on the ground and then go sunny again leaving the cotton fabric all creased
- The conditions that they are living in might be hard to work in meaning that if it was to rain, snow or just be really cold it could slow the process down.
